Visa requirements for **United States Nationals** Travelling to **South Africa** (via Heathrow)

- Passengers must have a passport, or another travel document accepted for entry
- Travel documents must be valid for at least 30 days longer than the duration of stay
- Travel documents issued to visitors **must have at least one empty visa page**
- Nationals of USA do not need a visa for a maximum of 90 days
- Visitors without a return/onward ticket could be refused entry
- **Machine Readable/Biometric Travel Documents Information**
Your passport must display this sign :



Transit Countries – UNITED KINGDOM

USA Nationals do require an ETA prior to boarding a UK bound flight. However, nationals of USA **can transit airside through London Heathrow (LHR) without** an Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA) on the same calendar day.

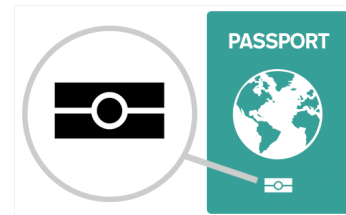
Yellow Fever Certificate

Passengers arriving from the USA and/or United Kingdom **DO NOT** require a Yellow Fever vaccination certificate

Visa requirements for **PANAMA & SPANISH Nationals** Travelling to **South Africa** (stopover *TURKEY*)

- Passengers must have a passport, or another travel document accepted for entry
- Travel documents must be valid for at least 30 days longer than the duration of stay
- Travel documents issued to visitors **must have at least one empty visa page**
- Nationals of PANAMA & SPAIN do not need a visa for a maximum of 90 days
- Visitors without a return/onward ticket could be refused entry
- **Machine Readable/Biometric Travel Documents Information**
Your passport must display this sign :



Stopover Countries – Türkiye

Nationals of Panama & Spain do not need a visa for a maximum of 90 days in a period of 180 days.

Yellow Fever Certificate

Passengers travelling from the Republic of Panama **DO** require a Yellow Fever vaccination certificate when arriving into South Africa.
